

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PINEY

BY-LAW NO. 51/08

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PINEY TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMUNERATION OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL.

Whereas subsection 124(2) of The Municipal Act, S.M. 1996, c. 58 provides as follows:

124 (2) A council may by by-law set the types, rates and conditions of payments to be made to or on behalf of members of the council and council committees, other than the committee of a local urban district,

- a) as compensation for attending to municipal business;
- b) for expenses incurred while attending to municipal business; and
- c) for any other purpose relating to municipal business that the council considers appropriate.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interest of The Rural Municipality of Piney to provide for the payment of compensation, expenses and for any other purpose relating to municipal business that the council considers appropriate;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS ENACTED AS A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PINEY AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT an indemnity of \$475.00 per month be paid to the Reeve.
2. THAT an indemnity of \$400.00 per month be paid to each Councillor.
3. THAT an indemnity of \$40.00 per meeting be paid to each Council Member in attendance at duly called Special Meetings.
4. THAT the mileage rate of forty-five cents (45 cents) per kilometer be paid to each member of the council for each kilometer, each way, travelled from his/her place of residence in the municipality, to the place of meeting and return to his/her place of residence, to be allowed only once for each meeting attended of the Council or committees thereof. Whenever practical, car pooling is encouraged when travelling beyond the limits of The R.M. of Piney when two or more delegates are attending.
5. THAT an indemnity of \$11.00 per hour shall be paid to a member of Council for each hour actually and necessarily spent by him/her in the performance of such duties, work or services as he/she is required or authorized to perform, plus mileage for each kilometer actually and necessarily travelled by him/her in the performance of the duties, work or services.
6. That an indemnity of \$11.00 per hour be paid to each Council Member in attendance at other meetings of interest within the Municipality plus travelling and actual living expenses as authorized by resolution of Council.
7. That an indemnity be paid to each Council Member in attendance plus mileage and actual living expenses, which he/she has been previously authorized by resolution specifying the purpose of the meeting journey beyond the limits of The R.M. of Piney actually engaged in travelling to, attendance at, and returning from the meeting:
 - Half day or evening meeting - \$50.00 plus \$11.00 per hour after four (4) hours;
 - Full day \$100.00 plus \$11.00 per hour after eight (8) hours.

8. THAT an indemnity of \$100.00 per day be paid to a member of the Council, plus mileage and actual living expenses, for each day he/she is actually engaged in travelling to, attendance at, and returning from a meeting of:
 - a) Association of Manitoba Municipalities; or
 - b) The Canadian Federation of Mayors and Municipalities; or
 - c) such other organizations that in the opinion of the Council it is in the interest of the Municipality to belong;which he/she had been previously authorized by resolution of the Council to attend.
9. Meal allowance as follows:
 - a) maximum of \$50.00 per day with proof of receipts
 - b) with no receipts: Breakfast \$5.00
Lunch \$10.00
Supper \$15.00
10. THAT the indemnity amounts referred to in items 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall be paid on the basis that two-thirds of the amount is a taxable income and one-third of the amount is a non-accountable expense allowance for taxable services and costs under The Excise Tax Act incident to the discharge of duties, work or services.
11. THAT all such compensation be paid on a monthly basis on the presentation of an approved expense form and approved by Resolution of Council.
12. THAT on the passing of this By-Law, The Rural Municipality of Piney By-Law No. 41/04 is rescinded.
