And Whereas the widespread damage to trees, power lines etc. creating undue hardship to residence in accessing and removal of debris on private and municipal properties;

And Whereas The Manitoba Disaster Financial Assistance Program may provide compensation for costs incurred by the private sector and by the Municipality;

Therefore Be It Resolved That The R.M. of Piney request Manitoba Emergency Measures to assist both the R.M. and private individuals with compensation due to the tornado damage in the hamlet of Sandilands on July 31, 2005;

And Further Be it Resolved that the Manitoba Emergency Measures be asked to send inspectors to determine the extent of damages to Municipal and private properties. Carried.
